



Dakota Relays Gold Medal Scholarship

Scholarship Purpose

This scholarship was established in 2000. It was created by the Howard Wood Dakota Relays Board of Directors to reward South Dakota Track & Field student athletes of accomplishment who have chosen to continue participation in the sport at the collegiate level.

Scholarship Eligibility

- Graduating senior at a South Dakota High School
- Actively participating in Track & Field
- Must have participated in a Howard Wood Dakota Relays Meet
- Committed to attend College/University and continue a Track & Field career.

Scholarship Criteria

- Athleticism as evidenced by Track & Field & other athletic accomplishments
- Scholarship as evidenced by a 3.2 overall grade point average
- Leadership as evidenced by the athlete's leadership roles on the track team, in other school activities, and through community involvement

Scholarship Amount

- Two one-time awards of \$1000 each to one male and one female athlete

Scholarship Application Procedures

- The application will be accessible through the Howard Wood Dakota Relays Web Page (www.dakotarelays.com)
- Applicants must provide:
 - 1) Completed, signed application
 - 2) A personal recommendation regarding the athlete from an adult who is not an immediate relative (to be sent directly from the reference—form enclosed)
 - 3) A brief essay titled “Why I Plan to Make Track & Field Part of My College Education”
 - 4) Two current photos for publication purposes

Scholarship Selection

- **A selection panel of community leaders who serve on the Howard Wood Dakota Relays Board of Directors has been appointed by the Board to be responsible for recommending scholarship awards based on the established guidelines. The considerations are:**
 - 1) Accomplishments in Track & Field (length of participation & level of accomplishment)**
 - 2) Academic qualifications**
 - 3) Participation in school & community activities**
 - 4) Accomplishments in other athletic activities**
 - 5) Personal recommendation**
 - 6) Personal statement/essay**
- **Interviews may be scheduled with finalists.**
- **Two recipients—one male and one female—will be chosen each year.**
- **The applicants must be present at the announcement ceremony. Recipients will be named at the Howard Wood Dakota Relays each May.**
- **Payment of scholarship awards will be made at the end of January to the educational institution/student upon receipt of written notification of the student's enrollment at that institution and a copy of the student's letter of intent to participate in that institution's Track & Field program.**
